The Audi Q4 Sportback e-tron 35 is an all-electric rear-wheel drive SUV. It came out in 2021. Audi stopped making the 35 in 2023. The car is not available on the US market.

The Audi Q4 Sportback e-tron 35 has a 55 kWh battery pack, allowing it to travel up to 183 mi on a single charge. The car has an average efficiency of 28.4 kWh per 100 miles (or 284 Wh/mile) — ranked №422 out of 586 electric vehicles.
