



Audi Q4 e-tron 40 (USA)

The Audi Q4 e-tron 40 is an all-electric rear-wheel drive SUV. It came out in 2021. Audi stopped making the 40 in 2024 and replaced it with the Audi Q4 e-tron 45. You can still find Audi Q4 e-tron 40 on the used car market, with prices starting around \$36,996.

The Audi Q4 e-tron 40 has a 82 kWh battery pack, allowing it to travel up to 264 mi on a single charge. The car has an average efficiency of 29 kWh per 100 miles (or 290 Wh/mile) — ranked №189 out of 586 electric vehicles.
