



Chevrolet Bolt EV 2020 (USA)

The Chevrolet Bolt EV 2020-2021 is an all-electric front-wheel drive hatchback. It came out in 2020 replacing the older Chevrolet Bolt EV 2017-2019. Chevrolet stopped making the 2020-2021 in 2021 and replaced it with the Chevrolet Bolt EV 2022-2024. You can still find Chevrolet Bolt EV 2020-2021 on the used car market, with prices starting around \$19,998.

The Chevrolet Bolt EV 2020-2021 has a 66 kWh battery pack, allowing it to travel up to 259 mi on a single charge. The car has an average efficiency of 24.2 kWh per 100 miles (or 242 Wh/mile) — ranked N°206 out of 586 electric vehicles.
