



Volkswagen ID.3 1st Edition (USA)

The Volkswagen ID.3 1st Edition is an all-electric rear-wheel drive hatchback. It came out in 2019. VW stopped making the 1st Edition in 2021 and replaced it with the Volkswagen ID.3 Pro (2020). The car is not available on the US market.

The Volkswagen ID.3 1st Edition has a 62 kWh battery pack, allowing it to travel up to 227 mi on a single charge. The car has an average efficiency of 25.6 kWh per 100 miles (or 256 Wh/mile) — ranked №314 out of 586 electric vehicles.
