



Tesla Model S Standard Range (USA)

The Tesla Model S Standard Range is an all-electric all-wheel drive liftback. It came out in 2019 replacing the older Tesla Model S 75D. Tesla stopped making the Standard Range in 2020 and replaced it with the Tesla Model S Long Range. You can still find Tesla Model S Standard Range on the used car market, with prices starting around \$33,994.

The Tesla Model S Standard Range has a 75 kWh battery pack, allowing it to travel up to 264 mi on a single charge. The car has an average efficiency of 27.5 kWh per 100 miles (or 275 Wh/mile) — ranked №189 out of 586 electric vehicles.
