The Audi SQ8 Sportback e-tron is an all-electric all-wheel drive SUV. It came out in 2023 replacing the older Audi e-tron Sportback S.

The Audi SQ8 Sportback e-tron has a 114 kWh battery pack, allowing it to travel up to 247 mi on a single charge. The car has an average efficiency of 42.9 kWh per 100 miles (or 429 Wh/mile) — ranked №247 out of 586 electric vehicles.
