The Mercedes EQE SUV 300 has a 98 kWh battery pack, allowing it to travel up to 287 mi on a single charge. The car has an average efficiency of 31 kWh per 100 miles (or 310 Wh/mile) — ranked №123 out of 586 electric vehicles.
