



Volkswagen ID.4 GTX (2021) (Europe)

The Volkswagen ID.4 GTX (2021) is an all-electric all-wheel drive SUV. It came out in 2021. VW stopped making the GTX (2021) in 2023 and replaced it with the Volkswagen ID.4 GTX (2022). The car is not available on the US market.

The Volkswagen ID.4 GTX (2021) has a 82 kWh battery pack, allowing it to travel up to 258 mi on a single charge. The car has an average efficiency of 29.8 kWh per 100 miles (or 298 Wh/mile) — ranked №210 out of 586 electric vehicles.
