



## Tesla Model X 100D (USA)

The Tesla Model X 100D is an all-electric all-wheel drive SUV. It came out in 2017 replacing the older Tesla Model X 90D. Tesla stopped making the 100D in 2019 and replaced it with the Tesla Model X Long Range. You can still find Tesla Model X 100D on the used car market, with prices starting around \$38,490.

The Tesla Model X 100D has a 100 kWh battery pack, allowing it to travel up to 279 mi on a single charge. The car has an average efficiency of 34.1 kWh per 100 miles (or 341 Wh/mile) — ranked №148 out of 586 electric vehicles.
