



## Audi e-tron 55 quattro (USA)

The Audi e-tron 55 quattro is an all-electric all-wheel drive SUV. It came out in 2019. Audi stopped making the 55 quattro in 2022 and replaced it with the Audi Q8 e-tron 55 quattro. You can still find Audi e-tron 55 quattro on the used car market, with prices starting around \$32,000.

The Audi e-tron 55 quattro has a 95 kWh battery pack, allowing it to travel up to 220 mi on a single charge. The car has an average efficiency of 39.3 kWh per 100 miles (or 393 Wh/mile) — ranked №340 out of 586 electric vehicles.
